The CAC acknowledged that the Council was copied on a letter from the Planning Board to the Town Board with regard to the Planning Board's response to the proposed creation of Local Land Use Advisory Committees and in response to the CAC's Letter of Support for these Committees.

TOWN INFORMATION:

- Collection and transportation (possibly with bio-diesel trucks) of organic waste – The CAC is interested in understanding the costs involved in biomass processing (i.e. costs involved in pickup, transportation, burning, etc.) and believes it is worth reaching out at the County level to get some information.

WETLANDS AND WATER COURSES PERMIT REFERRALS:

ON-GOING ITEMS - updates when available

- Update on status of Tree Law – no new discussion.
- Elmwood County Club – the CAC was informed that the Town received responses to its Requests for Qualifications (RFQ) for the Elmwood project's DEIS. It was also noted that the potential candidates are supposed to be interviewed the week of February 18, 2019. A Committee has put together qualification questions to be posed to the candidates. After these interviews, it is understood that the Town Board will interview 3 candidates.

- Excess Food for Needy Law – no new discussion.
- Development process and procedures – local land use advisory committees: no new discussion beyond what is noted above in "Correspondence".
- Alternate Member – The CAC was informed that the Legislation was changed to allow an alternate member for the CAC. Tim Lewis, the Town Attorney, is looking into why it has not yet been incorporated into the Town Code.
